

TRANSPORTATION OF MINOR PERSON TO/FROM SCHOOL CAMPUS

The Catholic Diocese of Phoenix "Policy on Sexual Misconduct" states that "Field trips or other outings involving a minor in places and situations where no other responsible adults are present..." are to be avoided. The directive of this provision requires that another adult should accompany Diocesan personnel who transport minors to and from field trips and outings.

Because of the limited number of participants in the **Sports Program** at **St. Gregory Catholic Elementary School** and the time of day in which program events will occur, it may not always be possible to have two adults occupying each vehicle transporting minors to and from the programs.
